#### Flood Warnings

Over recent weeks the weather has 'misbehaved' with several periods of very heavy rain leading to flooding on our roads. Where Floods are reported to the Police we will investigate and ensure signage is put up to warn motorists, however the problem arises when drivers ignore these signs and get stranded when their engines are 'waterlogged'; If you see Flood Warning signs please find an alternative route.

#### Theft from Motor Vehicles

Recently I was involved in a Police Operation organised by FARINGDON Neighbourhood Policing Team to patrol and observe beauty spots near the RIDGEWAY after a number of Thefts from vehicles. As a consequence 3 persons were arrested and subsequently charged in relation to Theft from vehicle offences.

Vale of White Horse District Council Environment Wardens advise the following; Under the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 a person who is in charge of a dog must clean up after it when it fouls any footpath, highway, verge or other open space to which the public have access. It is a crime to allow a dog to foul any public area without cleaning it up. By doing so you could face a fixed penalty notice of £50 or prosecution.

#### RENAISSANCE OF THE CHILDREY

Pfilitific GROUP A few of our villagers who used to paint together have decided to try & revive the Childrey Painting Group, especially now that we have such a beautifully restored village hall, with good light & space. We are simply a group who enjoy painting but find it difficult to find time to do any without the incentive of working with other like-minded people.
