

#### **BUS UPDATE**

As previously published the 67 and 38 bus services will stop on 24th July. The **Baulking UBW** (Uffington, Minibus Management Woolstone) Committee has been looking into ways in which it can help fill the gap. They are offering a Wantage Community service each Friday, starting in Uffington at 9.30am then calling at Kingston Lisle, Westcot, Sparsholt and Childrey on the way to Wantage town centre. This service will return from Wantage at around 11.30am. The UBW Friday service will start on 29th July and Bus Passes may be used. Any residents wishing to use this service must register by telephoning John Hatcher on 01367 820417. Then on the Fridays that they wish to travel the registered users must telephone John to ensure the driver of the minibus knows to pick them up in the Village. There is a possibility of another service to Wantage on a second day each week but this will be decided if there is a requirement. Can we please help to support this service. There is always a need for drivers and the commitment to drive is only around half a day every 4 weeks. Training will be given and age range is 18 to mid 70's. If you would like to help as a driver, please contact John Hatcher.

We have also investigated the proposed OCC service which intends deploy underutilized minibuses via a dial-a-ride type scheme. Unfortunately, this service will not be competitive as bus passes can't be used and the service is based in Abingdon.

Please get in touch if you are able to offer an early morning or evening lift to/from Wantage for residents who need to get to work.

## Childrey Village Pond

So far this year we have enjoyed the displays of yellow Marsh Marigold, the Cow Parsley and the yellow Flag Iris around the pond edges. Now is the time of the feathery sedges, one of which is the true bulrush. This should not to be confused with Reedmace (Typha), a plant often referred to as 'bulrush', which has tall sausage like brown seed heads. Even though it is good at absorbing nutrient from the

water, it was deliberately excluded from the planting plan because, if left alone, it is very invasive and would soon fill the pond. Reedmace has found its way into the pond on its own and needs to be controlled. It may seem a shame to cut these heads down as they are attractive, but it is essential to prevent seed scatter.

#### **Trimming Needed**

There are other plants which also need seasonally to be trimmed, especially on the path by Pond Farm.

For pedestrian safety, we need to carry

out this path trim soon, so if we can get a few people together, it shouldn't take us long. We are planning the path trim on Saturday 30th July, at 09.30am We already have a small group of people who turn up every time and give of their time we but would like to involve a larger group of village people, to spread the workload. If you have an interest in the appearance of the pond, and the pond habitat, could you spare a little time about twice a year? If so, you please do join us on 30<sup>th</sup> and going forward, to manage the plants around the pond. Just bring some gardening tools to cut back foliage - nothing special required. I am sure you will agree that it has been looking good this year and we want this to continue with your help.
