SEPTEMBER 2016

News from St Mary's Since our last newsletter we have made further investigations to find out exactly what is needed to repair the church roof following the theft of lead from the south transept in June. These have shown that the main beams are badly decayed so the repair will not be straightforward. We are now arranging a full structural examination. Initially the costs of repair were



estimated at £50,000. The insurance claim will give us only £6,500 because insurance for theft of lead from churches is very limited and because of a similar theft two years ago. We can find approximately £10,000 from our reserves.

Fortunately the current temporary coverings should last the winter but any repair will need to be protected from the weather while it is done, so with scaffolding and a temporary roof our final bill may well be in excess of the initial £50,000 estimate.

We shall try and obtain as much as we can from grants but


