Dear Friends,

April begins in Holy Week and there are a number of different services planned across the Ridgeway Churches. But, let us back track a little because it all starts with Palm Sunday on 29th March.

We are going to mark Jesus' entry into Jerusalem by having our own procession from West Challow to Childrey.
