The relocation of the Little Ducks Pre-School to a new site in the grounds of the Ridgeway Primary School is in full swing, with planning permission granted earlier this year. This is a really exciting time for us and has been many years in the making. The move is reliant on raising about £195,000 in total. Our own self-help fundraising has already raised more than £20,000, but we now need to approach a number of charitable trusts and grant bodies to bridge the gap. ### **Wantage Counselling Service**

Fiona Roper presented a cheque to Trustees Helen Carter and Adrian Rance on Thursday 11th June 2015 for £1500. This was half the monies raised from April's Mayor's Charity Flamenco Evening at The Beacon, Wantage.

It has been an extremely good few weeks recently, along with the Flamenco Evening donation, Wantage Counselling Service have also received donations of £195 from Wantage Bodybuilding and £82 from the Rose Hips Belly Dancers who performed outside The Bear Hotel recently as part of Wantage Presents.

This money will be used by Wantage Counselling Service to continue to provide affordable counselling for the benefit of the community's mental health, something which is often left out of the public eye.

Wantage Counselling Service was founded in 1984 to provide counselling for individuals, couples and young people in Oxfordshire, Berkshire, Wiltshire and beyond. WCS is particularly valuable as a voluntary addition for patients in need of long-term care beyond whatever the NHS can provide.

We see up to 50 people a week for short- or long-term counselling. As a BACP-accredited service we follow the British Association of Counselling and Psychotherapy's (BACP) Ethical Framework for Good Practice. WCS is a registered charity and aims to provide counselling irrespective of clients' ability to pay the full fee. We rely on events and donations such as this both to help raise awareness of our service and to fund it.

Please could we ask that you check your boundaries for overhanging branches and overgrown weeds and brambles. There have been complaints and it would be really helpful if each person could look around their own properties. Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) has also cut back on grass cutting so if possible please help to keep our villages tidy and attractive.

There is going to be a public consultation over the next 12 weeks about a possible change to the subsidised bus and Dial-a-Ride services in Oxfordshire. OCC would like to get your views so that they can fully understand all opinions and potential impacts. ORCC has been appointed the independent facilitator for the Consultation by OCC. A copy of the proposals can be picked up from your local Library. There will be a list of public meeting dates on the Notice Boards in each village but the nearest ones to us are Monday 6th July Didcot Civic Hall 4.00pm-5.30pm or Wednesday 8th July Abingdon Guild Hall 4.00pm-5.30pm.
